Documentary Proves Children Are Changing Color

When you ask Sunny Ariel about her new documentary she tells you a story, "I had left my business card sitting on the table, and I watched as my daughter picked it up and asked my grandson - not quite five years old - to read it. She wanted to show me how well he could read. The card read, "The New Kids are here...in the world, to change the world." He read it perfectly, except that he replaced the word change with the word challenge. My daughter said, 'No, that's not what it says, read it again.' Two more times while looking straight at me, my grandson reiterated - and insisted - the line read, 'In the world to challenge the world.'"

And, indeed, if you have any contact with today's children, you know that these "new kids" are challenging the way we think. Within the ranks of this latest generation of children we find an unusual amount of gifted geniuses (according to scientists), successful entrepreneurs, compassionate volunteers, extraordinary intuitives, gifted healers, violent anarchists and bored drops-outs. They seem to have a built-in lie detector and know exactly who's who, and what's what. They're uncannily plugged in, and know

the real deal when they see it. Parents who are used to having control over their children's lives may have the biggest challenge with this new wave of youth. Many of these children are being prescribed Ritalin as a solution to behavior parents find uncomfortable or unruly. The message being sent by doctors, drug companies and parents is, the children need to be "fixed".

Visionary producer, Sunny Ariel, says these young people are known as "Indigo Children". The term referring to a belief that some children, especially those born after the late 1970s, represent a higher state of human evolution. The term itself is a reference to the belief that such children have an indigo colored aura. However, Ariel says, "Labels are useless, these kids are evolving and changing faster than most of us can keep up with."

Ariel has spent the last three years studying these children, and says her intention is to awaken the world to the possibilities these children have to offer. She loves to share what happened recently when she showed the film "The Secret" (a film consisting of a series of interviews and dramatizations related to "The

Law of Attraction") to a group of about ten kids in Albuquerque, New Mexico, "I was expecting to film their excited responses after viewing the film, and was shocked when I heard them say, 'Duh, we already know this stuff!'"

Indeed. Ariel adds, "I am making this film to encourage you to know your child. You will truly see who your kids are, and understand that they can only give as much as we allow them to."

USA TODAY, CNN, Good Morning America, A & E, and the New York Times have all reported on the growing phenomenon of these "new kids." Ariel says this documentary will prove that these Indigo Children, - in the words of both the kids themselves and those who study them - are here to redefine, redesign, and break down current human boundaries.
